NHK Ent<mark>erprises aims to meet the SDGs via the motto, "bringing people together."</mark>

On November 5, 2019, NEP joined the SDG Media Compact, a United Nations initiative encouraging the world's media organizations to help raise awareness of the SDGs.

Through our business activities, we are uniting the efforts of people and organizations who are working to solve the environmental and social problems that threaten our planet, such as climate change.



In addition to raising awareness among the public, we continue to advance the SDGs in our activities by pursuing eco-friendly operations, such as reducing energy consumption and waste generation.

"Connecting" is the keyword to our mission to contribute to a future where people can thrive more than ever. In line with our vision to "be bold, be innovative and be constructive!" we will harness NEP's strengths in content production and our nationwide network to build connections between people, between companies, and between countries. In doing so, we intend to also forge a connection between current and future generations, and build bridges from our world today to a better world tomorrow.

Sustainable Production Sites

"Sustainable production" is about reducing the environmental impact of the production process. We build sets using materials with a low environmental impact, reuse them in various ways, and throw away as little as possible. We reduce travel-related CO2 emissions by conducting editing sessions and meetings remotely, and by cooperating with staff on location. As a trial for new technology, we're drastically reducing travel requirements by introducing virtual production, and reducing paper usage by sharing scripts via tablets. Efforts are ongoing, and we're still a long way from the 1.5 target. But we'll endeavor to keep improving.



Promoting the SDGs through programs and content



Through video content, including NHK programs, and through the planning and production of events, NEP works on the SDGs in a diverse set of categories, including climate change, biodiversity, the aging of society, universal services, regional issues, and education. Our message is that content has the power to address a wide range of problems. In recent years, people are increasingly tackling issues in unique ways, and forming unprecedented alliances. As planning and production professionals, we strive to showcase these fantastic initiatives, and demonstrate our commitment to delivering them. Together, we'll work towards a brighter future.



NEP partners with communities and companies to contribute to society. In addition to our Tokyo main office, we have seven branch offices around Japan, and we use this network to collaborate on local events. These include "SDGs with Ninjaboy"—display panels that use characters to teach children about the SDGs—and a digital exhibition that illustrates environmental issues with footage from "Darwin's Amazing Animals." We also contribute to disaster prevention and mitigation by exhibiting at a disaster prevention event in Shibuya. We'll continue working to share the disaster prevention knowledge accumulated by the NHK Group.

Reducing NEP's environmental impact

From the 2022 fiscal year, NEP's main office switched to renewable electricity. At branch offices, carbon offsetting has reduced CO2 emissions from measurable electricity to practically zero. In order to achieve a sustainable global environment, we'll take responsibility in our daily activities, and endeavor to improve. Measures include reducing electricity usage, reducing waste—including paper, plastic bottles and files—donating used books, promoting hot-desking, and reducing the CO2 emissions of travel by utilizing remote working.



Making work comfortable for all



NEP is committed to pursuing diversity, equality, and inclusion (DE&I). With strong relationships among colleagues, built through work, we aim to foster growth and respect individuality. Our efforts to achieve a work-life balance include supporting parents by contributing to babysitting costs and encouraging the use of parental leave. We support personal growth through training programs in and out of Japan, and though a "self-improvement leave" initiative that helps employees achieve their life goals. Also, we started using a communication app called "Thanks," after a young employee came up with the idea. Staff can "thank" and "support" each other, and there's a reward system for the most popular posts. We're building an environment where every member of our diverse workforce feels enthusiastic about their work.





Archives

NHK Archives preserves all the programs that stream on NHK 365 days a year in a content database. We also provide the public with previously broadcast programs, news footage, and more. The NHK Archives business unlocks the values of this vast collection of video resources through NEP's deep expertise in storing, rights management, and delivery of video.


Program Library for Online University Classes

NHK Archives Operations

NHK Archives, with its holdings of programs broadcast by NHK as well as other video materials, is the largest database of audiovisual content in Japan. The video and audio content broadcast each day is tagged with metadata and stored to optimize searchability and exploitability.



Rights clearance and procurement

In addition to rights clearance and procurement for making and broadcasting original programming, we provide a wide range of rights management services associated with providing programs for secondary usage. We supply programming to NHK On Demand, and to other VOD providers. We have an impressive track record in handling rights management for the booming streaming sector. Footage Licensing

NHK Archives holds a wealth of multimedia material including audio, photographic materials and high-resolution video (including 4K video) that are widely supplied to broadcasters and streaming service operators around the world. These archives are a valuable source of footage for broadcast programs, commercials, events, publications and more. Preview and transfer of materials can be done on the web.



Licensing of NHK programs

We are able to supply programs broadcast on NHK and videos produced by NEP to meet the needs of our customers. We handle the rights management for museums and other facilities so they may screen programs as part of their exhibits, for companies as part of employee training, and more.

We are able to provide end-to-end solutions, from editing footage to implementing systems.





Sales (end of FY)




Percentage of sales by business (FY2024)


